

## Cooperation for quality education for children at social risk EDU no borders ELRII-310 outputs and results

### Outputs

**17 joint culture events implemented in Estonia, Latvia and Russia**

**25 cross-border activities for students** organised (workshops, seminars, meetings, excursions, concerts)

**46 seminars and trainings** for teachers, specialists, parents, students arranged

**4 educational cross border visits between schools** with participation of students, teachers, specialists organised

**1967 hours of lessons by special educators for children** with special educational needs conducted

**Methodological materials, literature, educational materials, study tools, IT equipment** for schools purchased

**1 guidebook about good practices and experiences** what were gained in cross-border cooperation issued in four languages (Estonian, Latvian, Russian and English)

**21 press visits to schools and SOS families** organised

**1 conference targeted to specialists** working with orphans and children at social risk organised in Pskov, Russia

**1 final conferences** with participation of representatives from Estonia, Latvia and Russia organised in Tartu, Estonia on actual educational issues

## RESULTS

**Qualitative and inclusive educational system improved in 4 schools of border regions** in Estonia, Latvia and Russia involving about 700 students

**Over 160 teachers and specialists acquired new knowledge and skills** in working with children at social risk and realised their competence while working with students with special educational needs

**About 200 students** have got better knowledge **how to prevent and solve the problems** in their everyday lives

**Over 100 parents** have improved knowledge about the **principles of raising and supporting children**, networking with teachers and child protection specialists

**Improved the quality of life of children at social risk** in Estonia, Latvia and Russia.

**Over 2400 students** benefit from **diversified learning process in border areas**
